

Invisible Labour of Public Involvement

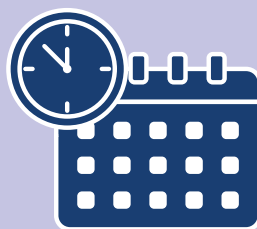
